Discover something unique and beautiful among the eclectic mix at Adelaide's stylish new kid on the block, Etienne

Since opening its doors in April last year, Etienne has been distracting drivers along Unley Road, in Adelaide's leafy inner city fringe, with its large and inviting window displays. Owner Juliet Berry opened a namesake store – a close friend calls her Etienne – after falling in love with the light, airy space. Inside, a collection of on-trend and seasonal homewares and gifts are spread throughout the large, sun-drenched space. “Very eclectic pieces that make a statement,” says Juliet. “I love designs that are not only

aesthetically pleasing but also useful for day-to-day life.” Weathered wooden furniture sits alongside leather ottomans, blown-glass vases, Zulu urns and brightly coloured cushions. In addition, you'll find luxurious bathroom treats, gorgeous toys, clothing for children and a range of modern jewellery, including pieces by designers Cat Hammill and Samantha Willis. Life and colour are brought to the space via works by the artists in residence, whom Juliet welcomes throughout the year. “I want my shoppers to feel inspired,” she says. Mission accomplished! ■
